

## Inshallah – London



New to London this September is a music group entitled, “Inshallah – London”. It will take its model from the “Inshallah” choir from the Kanata Centre for Global Song in Waterloo, ON formed in 2007. It will be an Non-auditioned, Non-denominational, multi-faith choir which will use the guiding principles of:

- providing a welcoming space where singers of all levels can find joy in singing and meaning in sung prayer
- nurturing a spirituality of openness, vulnerability and mutuality
- proclaiming a gospel of love that challenges injustice and affirms the flourishing of humanity and all of creation.
- executing a leadership practice where musical integrity is valued, but *participation* rather than *perfection* is the goal
- intentionally learning about original context of the song and re-contextualizing the song within Canada and our community
- singing global songs in the wider community and seeking singers originally from other countries of Indigenous communities who would like to share their song\*
